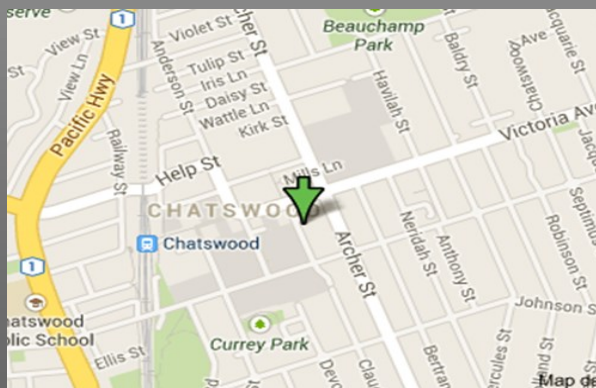

Children's Orthodontics

The optimum age to commence orthodontic treatment is between 8-10 years. At this stage, the bones and muscles are growing rapidly, making it an opportune time to guide further growth and development. This early intervention allows the creation of the best bite to move into adolescence and adulthood, minimising further functional concerns.

As a specialist Orthodontic practice we will work closely with your general dentist to provide a high level of care and the desired result. Throughout treatment we strongly recommend that you continue to visit your general dentist every six months for a check-up to maintain your dental health.

The aims of early treatment are:

- Creating space for crowded, erupting teeth
- Creating facial symmetry through influencing jaw growth
- Reducing the risk of trauma to protruding front teeth
- Preserving space for the uninterrupted teeth
- Reducing the need for tooth removal
- Reducing treatment time with braces

Adult Orthodontics

Orthodontic treatment at later stages in life can dramatically improve your personal appearance and self-esteem. Improving the health of your teeth and gums is equally important. Crooked teeth and a bad bite can contribute to gum and bone loss, tooth decay, abnormal wear of the tooth enamel and surfaces, headaches and jaw joint (TMJ/TMD) pain.
